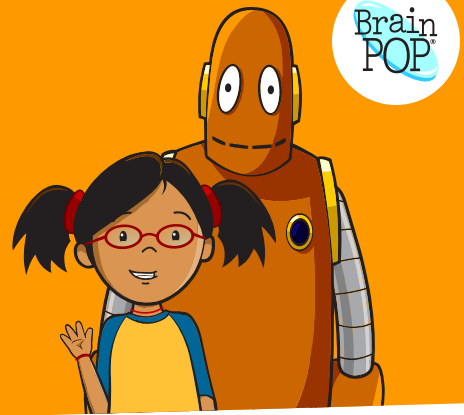

Family Tips Maximize your students' comprehension at home with some easy family tips, like using the pause button, the Read About It feature and activity pages.
