

# Creating a Simple Podcast with GarageBand 09

To record a simple podcast in GarageBand 09

1. From the project window, select Podcast.



2. Name the file.
3. If you are adding pictures or scanned artwork, click on the Photos tab in the Media Browser. You will be able to access all photos in iPhoto from here, so always put images you plan to use into iPhoto prior to making your podcast.
4. Drag the first photo for your podcast into the Podcast Track.



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5. Click on either Male or Female Voice Track. To begin recording, click on the red record button at the bottom of the GarageBand window. Begin recording audio to accompany image in the podcast track.



6. To stop recording, press the spacebar on the keyboard.
7. Drag the next image into the podcast track, click on either Male or Female Voice track, and record the audio for that image.
8. Repeat until all images and recordings have been completed.
9. To convert the podcast into an iTunes or Quicktime movie file, you will need to Share or Export it as follows:

- iTunes: Go up to Share...Send Podcast to iTunes
- Quicktime Movie: Go up to Share... Export Podcast to disk.
  1. An .m4a file will appear on your desktop.
  2. To have it open with QuickTime (vs. iTunes), click once on the podcast icon and go up to File...Get info.



3. Next to “Open with” choose Quicktime Player.
